THE FOOD!

We have a team of cooks based at our accommodation that will provide you with 3 home cooked meals daily, these consist of stews, pasta, vegetable dishes, chapati's and more.



WHAT IS THE ACCOMMODATION LIKE?



YTA provide volunteers with a guest house booked out for your group only! The accommodation is shared rooms, and has 24hr security within the guesthouse and outside the compound.

TRANSPORT WHILST IN KENYA

YTA provides a bus for airport and day to day transport which seats 22 people and this is for your groups disposal throughout the trip.
